A Family Legacy Endures...

A Family Legacy Endures, from Private Family Foundation to Donor Advised Fund.

Ted and Sherry Spanner have transitioned their Spanner Foundation into a Hibbing Foundation Donor Advised Fund. A Donor Advised Fund will allow the Spanners to continue managing their fund as they have for many years.

The Spanners share a love of helping Iron Range students pursue higher education, a commitment to philanthropy, and a desire to honor family traditions. Ted's father, Lee Spanner believed in giving back and dedicated his life to community service.

When Merva Spanner, Lee Spanner's wife, passed away in 1981, the Spanner family directed the memorials to be used to help purchase new choir robes for Hibbing High School. This gift was the catalyst for the Spanner family's charitable giving - they found enjoyment in 'giving back' and HHS greatly appreciated the gift; everyone benefited.

Lee Spanner with son Ted and daughter-in-law Sherry, established a private family foundation in 1982 to enable the

Spanner family to express their appreciation to the people of Northern Minnesota for helping make their businesses successful during the past 60 years. The purpose of the Spanner Foundation was to award scholarships to students of Hibbing, Chisholm, Nashwauk/Keewatin and Hibbing Community College.

In 1983, the Spanner Foundation made its first scholarship grant award. Over the next 23 years, the Spanner Foundation has awarded scholarship support to 172 recipients. "It's a good feeling to be able to 'give-back' and make a difference for young adults pursuing higher education", said Sherry Spanner.

Throughout the years, the Spanner Foundation has made a difference through scholarship support and has also been an avenue for teaching Ted and Sherry's two daughters, Sarah and Rebecca about family philanthropy. "My parents have kept a journal including photos of most of the graduates who have received scholarships", said Sarah Spanner Henke. "Some people have kept in touch with my parents through letters and Christmas cards", added daughter, Rebecca Spanner Schulte. They both agreed
